

TK-1st

Please note that these field trips are for those going into TK, K, or 1st grade in the fall. TK-1st Field Trips for this age group are on Tuesdays.

NOTE: Extra Costs for field trips are also on the online registration page. You will be billed for A+, as well as billed for any additional charges we incur for field trips.

June 25--Fire Department in Tahoe City--TK-1st --no extra charge

- Be at the church by 10:30. We will be back to the church by 12:30
- Bring a lunch, snack, and a drink
- Wear tennis shoes or closed toe shoes that are back strapped.
- Put sunscreen on your child before you arrive. Put sunscreen in your child's backpack with their name on it.

July 2nd—All Fired Up—TK-1st \$18 extra charge

- Be at the church by 10:30. Done with All Fired Up by 12:30
- You may want to have your child wear an old shirt, in case they get paint on it. All Fired Up will come to the church. The kids will paint their pieces. We will put the name on each child's art. All Fired Up will then take the pottery back to their store, and fire the pieces. In a few days, they will then bring them back to the church. We will put them on a table in the entry way so that you can pick up your child's pottery.
- Bring a lunch, a snack, and a drink
- Put on sunscreen before arriving at A+. Put sunscreen in your child's backpack with their name on it.

July 9--Commons Beach--TK-1st No extra charge

- Be at the church by 12:30 pm. We will return by 3:30 pm
- Bring a lunch, snack, and a drink
- Please have your child wear their swimsuit under your clothes. Bring extra undergarments so your child can put them on when they change out of their wet bathing suit.
- Bring a towel with your child's name on it.
- We are walking to the beach so wear tennis shoes or closed toe shoes that have are back strapped.
- Put on sunscreen before arriving at A+. Put sunscreen in your child's backpack with their name on it.

July 16--Wild Island—TK-1st--\$25 extra charge

- Please be at the church by 8:30 am. We will return to the church by 6:00 pm
- You cannot bring any food into the park. **Please give your child's cash spending money for lunch and a snack to Debbie upon your arrival at A+.** Smaller bills (ones and fives) are greatly appreciated. Debbie is the banker. This prevents children from losing their money. I also make them put on more sunscreen, before I give them their spending money. Your child will need a minimum of \$10 for your child's lunch. Your

child will probably also want an afternoon snack. The cost of food in the park is equivalent to eating at the ski areas. \$15 total spending money is plenty. Any leftover money your child has will be returned when we get back to the church. There are water fountains at the park.

- There are 35 lifeguards on duty at Wild Island at all times. There are life jackets available at no extra charge. **All children will be required by A+ to wear a life jacket to get into the wave pool.**
- We are asking that your child wear sandals or flip flops, so that we don't have to deal with lost socks. Please put your child's name on anything you would like to see again.
- We will be in the sun for about 5 hours. Please put sunscreen on your child before they come. Also, please put sunscreen with your child's name on it in their backpack.
- Each child will need to bring a towel with their name on it.
- Please have your child wear their swimsuit under your clothes. Bring extra undergarments so your child can put them on when they change out of their wet bathing suit.

July 23—Discovery Museum--TK-1st--\$10 extra charge

- Be at A+ by 9:00am. We will return by 3:00 pm
- We will have a ratio of one teacher for every 5 children.
- Groups of 5 children will rotate through each station they have at the Discovery Museum.
- Please send your child with lunch, two snacks, and a drink. Please put these in a backpack.
